Managing high quality fields under high traffic situations

Ryan Bjorn, New England Patriots

This session will go over different techniques and practices that can help turf managers improve the quality of their playing surfaces without sacrificing use

Running Track Maintenance and Life Cycle Expectations

Description: This session will describe the benefits of re-using infill on a synthetic turf replacement installation; the equipment needed, the process, testing and reduction of costs. We will also tour the indoor facility where there is removable indoor turf. We will describe the type of system, the benefits of a modular system and storage requirements.
